# Braeside Hospital



## Accessing our facilities



Braeside Hospital is a 10 to 15 minute walk from the Prairiewood T-way bus stop. There is a level walk up Prairievale Rd to the hospital.



CityRail stations with connecting buses to Braeside Hospital include:

**Fairfield station** on the South line. Catch a connecting 826 bus to the hospital.

**Liverpool station** on the South, Inner West and Bankstown lines. Catch a connecting T80 bus to Prairiewood Stop and then walk to the hospital.

**Parramatta station** on the Western line. Catch a connecting T80 bus to Prairiewood Stop and then walk to the hospital.



Safe cycling options include the Orphan School Creek Cycleway and the Parramatta to Liverpool T-way cycle path. Cycling maps are available at [www.cyclingconnectingcommunities.net](http://www.cyclingconnectingcommunities.net) or [www.fairfieldcity.nsw.gov.au](http://www.fairfieldcity.nsw.gov.au)



Bicycle parking is available outside the physiotherapy department. Shower and locker facilities are available for staff.



**Westbus 826** operates between Fairfield and Cabramatta and stops at the hospital. It runs approximately every 30 minutes Monday to Saturday and approximately every 60 minutes on Sundays and Public Holidays.

**T-way T80** operates between Parramatta and Liverpool stations and stops at the Prairiewood T-way bus stop. It runs every 10 minutes in peak hours and every 15 to 20 minutes in off-peak hours.

**Westbus routes 827 and 800** also stop near the hospital in Lily St.

**South West Community Transport Inc.** transport frail aged people, younger people with a disability and their carers. Phone 4629 6888 for more details.



Wheelchair accessible buses operate on all T80 services. Call 9890 0000 to check times of wheelchair accessible buses on Westbus routes.



Limited mobility parking is available at the hospital for people displaying their current Mobility Parking Scheme card in their car. See map for details.
