

Transport

Generally patients should make their own way to therapy. This could be by Public or Community transport, taxi services, personal transport or with the assistance of relatives.

Transport is available for people who have no other alternative way to get here. Details of requirements should be given when making an appointment.

Parking

Parking is available on site for a fee in coins of \$4.00.

Frequent visitors may enquire at reception regarding access cards.

Public Transport

Westbus 826 operates between Fairfield and Cabramatta and stops near the hospital.

Westbus 827 & 800 also stop near the hospital in Lily St.

T-way T80 operates between Parramatta and Liverpool stations and stops at the Prairiewood T-way bus stop. This is a 10 to 15 minute walk from the hospital.

Welcome to the Day Hospital



The Rehabilitation Day Hospital provides a safe comfortable environment where people who require two or more therapy appointments can relax between sessions.

Therapy appointments will be coordinated for the same day. Between appointments, you will stay in the Day Hospital, and be supervised by a Nurse. Recreational activities will be available.

Carers may leave their family member in the Rehabilitation Day Hospital with the knowledge that they will be professionally cared for and taken to therapy sessions.

Patients attending the Rehabilitation Day Hospital must be registered with the Rehabilitation Team to utilise the service.

Patients will have access to the Nurse Coordinator who will manage the patient's therapy appointments with a range of our health professionals.

These professional may include a:

- Physiotherapist
- Occupational therapist
- Speech pathologist
- Social worker
- Neuro/Clinical Psychologist
- Dietitian
- Diversional Therapist.

Patients will also have access to the following services should they require them:

- Rehabilitation Clinical Nurse Specialist/ Consultant
- Medical Officer
- Chaplain.

Groups

A Community Living Skills and Community Mobility Group are also run through the Rehabilitation Day Hospital.

Location and times

The Rehabilitation Day Hospital is located within Braeside Hospital, and is currently open Monday to Fridays from 9am to 3pm.

Interpreters

All attempts will be made to book interpreters should one be required, but if none is available then family may be requested to be present for therapy sessions.

Meals

A light lunch will be supplied to patients if therapies extend beyond midday. Vending machines are available for purchase of limited food items. Tea and coffee facilities are available at no cost.

You are welcome to bring your own requirements for the day.

Cost

There is no cost for anyone attending the Day Hospital.

Medication

Patients are requested to bring their own medications with them for the day.

What to wear & bring

Wear comfortable clothing that is easy to manage, such as slacks, tracksuits, skirts, supportive footwear. Bring incontinent supplies/requirements, if needed.

Smoking

Note, smoking is not permitted in the hospital building.
